
Base

# Step 01

MOVING THE BASE INTO POSITION.

**This product is heavy. Please have two or more people perform this step.**

To move the base, lift it by holding the top plate in between each quarter as shown. Once the base is in position, rotate the adjustable glides to ensure the table is level.





## Step 02

ALIGN THE TOP WITH THE BASE.

**Please have two or more people perform this step.**


Place the top on the base with the bolt locations facing down. A) The top has eight total mounting points but only four are used. This allows for the option to choose how to align the wood grain with the base.




# Step 03


ATTACH THE TOP TO THE BASE.


Loosely attach the bolts as shown, then tighten each bolt once all are threaded.

## Additional Information

### CLEAN

Clean with a slightly damp, soft cloth. To remove dirt and fingerprints, use a quality cleaner formulated for wood furniture. Wipe completely dry with a soft cloth in the direction of the wood grain.

### MARBLE

Natural stone top will have variances in appearance and each piece is unique. To help avoid stains we recommend sealing the honed marble, this should be done every year or two to keep the surface protected. Please contact your local hardware store for professional guidance.
