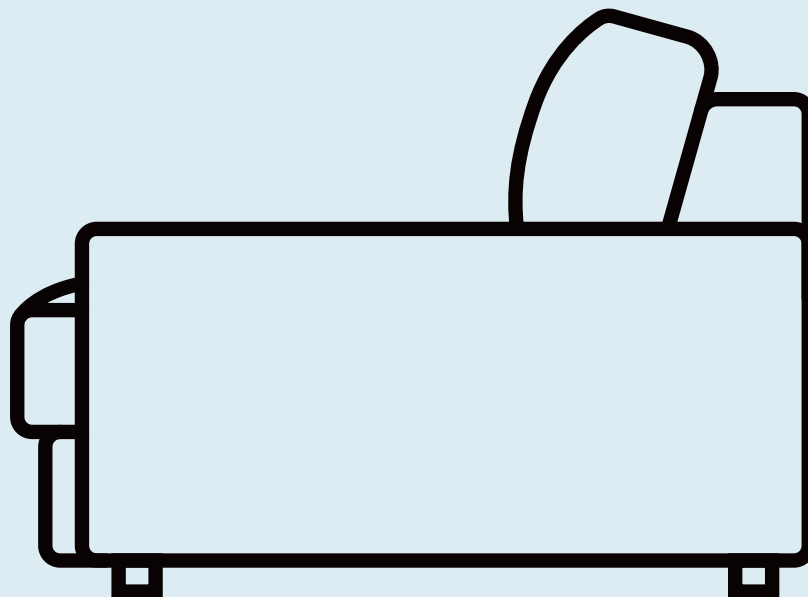
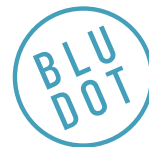


# Esker Sleeper Sofa

## ASSEMBLY

Some sofa configurations ship with connector hardware attached to the bottom of the sectional pieces. Carefully align the hardware and push sectional pieces together to lock into place.

## CLEAN

Vacuum your upholstery regularly.

## SPILLS

Act quickly with spills. Absorb the spill with a clean white cloth or paper towel. Never rub the surface. For **Velvet**, do not use water or other liquids to clean, as they may cause stains. **Kelso Sand, Kelso Blue, and Vos Evergreen**, can be cleaned and sanitized using bleach or any additional disinfectants without experiencing color loss or degradation. Consult a commercial cleaning specialist for removal of stubborn stains.

## AVOID

Keep furniture out of direct sunlight and away from heat sources; excessive exposure to sunlight may cause color fading. Avoid placing heavy or sharp objects on the furniture surface for long periods of time; this can cause permanent surface indentations. For snags in the fabric, tuck loose threads into fabric or carefully push to reverse side. Never pull out or cut off loose threads.

## SAFETY TIPS:

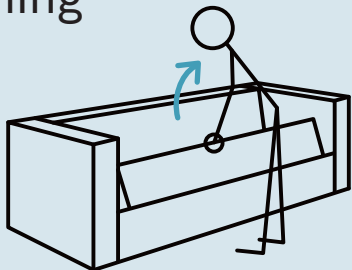
- NEVER ALLOW CHILDREN TO OPERATE.
- KEEP HANDS AWAY FROM SIDES WHEN OPERATING AND CLOSING.

## CAUTION: BEFORE OPENING

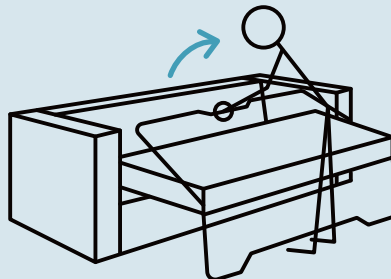
Remove the straps or cardboard blocks of the sleeper mechanism by carefully removing the staples. These blocks protect the unit during delivery.

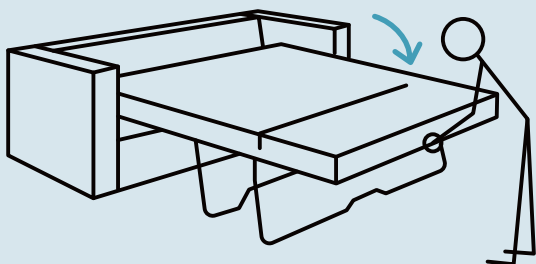

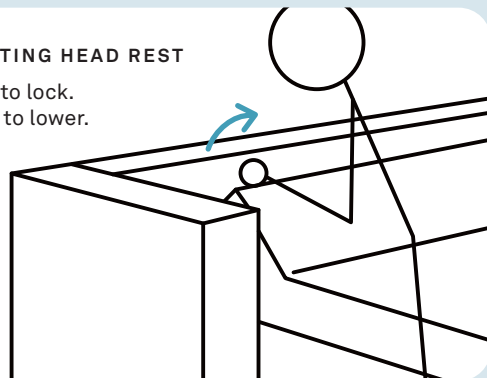

Foot tube must be fully depressed and locked before unit is closed. Failure to do so may result in damage to wooden frame or mechanism.

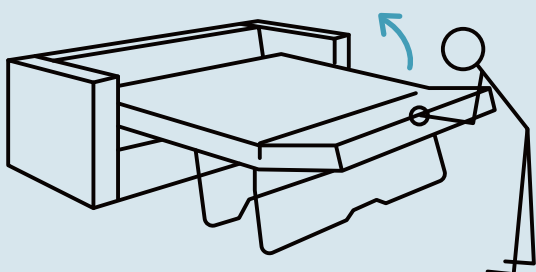
## OPERATING HEAD REST

Repeat to lower.

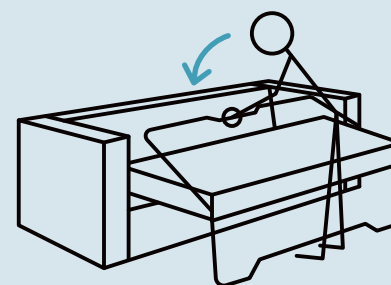
