



COPING MECHANISM.

Step 01

ATTACHING THE FEET.


Begin by attaching the round adhesive pads to the feet. Attach the feet to the side rails as shown using the provided hardware.



Step 02

ATTACHING THE FOOTBOARD.


Attach the footboard to the side rails using the provided hardware as shown. Note hole location to help identify left vs. right side rails.



Step 03


ATTACHING THE HEADBOARD.

With the help of a second person, align the headboard bolt holes with the foot bracket holes. Attach as shown using the provided hardware.



* Platform storage bed ships with two footboards.





Step 04

ATTACHING THE FRAME BRACKETS.


Begin by installing the adhesive pads to the top of the frame brackets. Locate the pairs of horizontal holes on the inner face of the frame. Attach the frame brackets as shown using the provided hardware.









Step 05

INSTALLING THE FABRIC COVERS.


Begin attaching the slip cover at the inner footboard corners and work up to the headboard. Wrap the slip cover around the frame and attach at the bottom using the velcro strips. Pull the dust barrier to the frame sides and attach the velcro strips.



Step 06

ATTACHING THE LIFT PISTONS.


Remove the x2 pre-attached lock nuts. Rotate the lift pistons and place over the threaded posts on the frame. Secure using the provided hardware. Repeat for remaining lift mechanism.



Step 07

ATTACHING THE LIFT MECHANISMS.



Align the support panels and the lift mechanisms with the side frame holes. Attach as shown using the provided hardware.



Step 08

ATTACHING THE CROSS SUPPORTS.

With the help of a second person, align the cross supports with the pre-drilled holes on the lift mechanisms. Attach using the provided hardware as shown.



ASSEMBLING THE MATTRESS FRAME.

Align mattress frames with wood slats on the floor as shown. Attach using the provided hardware as shown.

ATTACHING THE MATTRESS FRAME.

With the help of a second person, align the mattress frame with the pre-drilled holes on the lift mechanisms. Attach using the provided hardware as shown.



NOTE: Wood slats should be facing up.




Lowering Lift Mechanism



IMPORTANT

Before using the lift mechanism ensure storage area, bed frame, and surrounding area are free of pets or small children. Never put your hands on the sides or bottom of the lift mechanism when in use.





STEP 1

Begin by standing at the side of the bed. Pull the handle up and towards the headboard. While doing so push down and toward the headboard with your other hand.



STEP 2



The lift mechanism will support itself in this position with most mattresses. When ready to fully lower mattress **ensure storage area, bed frame, and surrounding area are free of pets or small children.** Stand at the side of the bed and push down and towards the footboard with both hands.



Raising Lift Mechanism



IMPORTANT

Before using the lift mechanism ensure storage area, bed frame, and surrounding area are free of pets or small children. Never put your hands on the sides or bottom of the lift mechanism when in use.





STEP 1

Begin by standing at the foot of the bed. Pull the handle up and towards the headboard. While doing so place other hand on top of frame to slow lift movement if desired. Do not place head or body in path of lift mechanism during use.



STEP 2

The lift mechanism will support itself in this position with most mattresses. This is ideal for storing or retrieving items from the storage area. Refer to Pg.12 on how to lower mattress from this position. The lift mechanism can also extend further, to do so pull the handle up and towards the footboard.



Additional Information

CLEAN

Vacuum your upholstery regularly. For leather furniture dust regularly with a dry cloth.

SPILLS

Act quickly with spills. Absorb the spill with a clean white cloth or paper towel. Never rub the surface. Do not use water or other liquids to clean, as they may cause stains. Consult a commercial cleaning specialist for removal of stubborn stains.

AVOID

Keep furniture out of direct sunlight and away from heat sources; excessive exposure to sunlight may cause color fading. Avoid placing heavy or sharp objects on the furniture surface for long periods of time; this can cause permanent surface indentations. For snags in the fabric, tuck loose threads into fabric or carefully push to reverse side. Never pull out or cut off loose threads.
